

## INSTRUCTED TO INQUIRE INTO TURK OUTRAGES

Washington Sept. 27.—Ambassador Morgenthau, at Constantinople, was today instructed to inquire into reported outrages against Armenians in Turkey, to ascertain if any victims are American citizens by birth or naturalization.

So far nothing has been received from the embassy at Constantinople to indicate that American citizens have suffered but American mission property has been taxed and threatened with confiscation.

The reported murder of two American missionaries still is unconfirmed.
